



	Stair-Step Leader Certification Process & Non-Leader Options:
Step 1	Someone reads or attends a Toolshop® resource/program teaching the UB®
	Invitation <u>in resource</u> to become a "Content Contributor" *
Step 3	Jody compiles the content to create <i>supplemental</i> niche Toolshop® resources & programs. NEED PT/RT LEADER CERTIFICATION for remaining steps:
Step 4	Anyone in that niche can become Certified Advisors to provide 1:1 & Group coaching in applying UB® to that niche.
Step 5	If they want to <u>teach</u> others the UB® (as a trainer for on– and off-line Toolshop® programs), they get GF certification and can use niche resources for the classes.
Step°6	If the gravant to concauthor NEW niche-specific curricula/resources/programs, they can become RT Experts.





RTITI rights to CC's Submissions

- a. Advanced T.I.P.S.
- b. TIPS4Leaders (post-test, skill assessment, listen to teleseminars, 3 Hintbook)
- c. Advisor cert training

Advisors can offer group coaching & support for using/applying BASIC T.I.P.S. (using existing niche resources) (Can't teach the UB®)

PT/RT LEADER CERTIFICATION for:

Step 5

If Advisors want to train the program/trainers, they get GF cert

- to teach the UB® & offer coaching & support for using/applying the UB®
- a. TIPS4Leaders (post-test, skill assessment, listen to teleseminars, 3 Hintbook)
- b. GF cert training

GFs can offer live local classes + be "instructors" for generic/universal on-line ADVANCED T.I.P.S. (parents have the niche resources)

NEW Leader Requirements: Stair-step

PT/RT LEADER CERTIFICATION for:



If DSPs (Advisor + GF) want to **co-author NEW niche resources/ programs**, become RT **Experts** (current model)

- a. More thorough screening & assessments (personality, business skills, biz partner compatibility) & up-front contracts (IP atty or publisher?)
- b. Teach at least 3 full-length generic/universal TIPS classes to their niche (using available materials) with skill assessments and evaluations. Outcomes are in top 2 highest ranges for each.
 - c. Submit niche-specific notes for each Toolbox/Toolset chapter
- d. Submit 10 Hintbook PASRR solutions to the "Top 10 Challenges" of their niche.
- ¹² All RT Experts receive 1st-mention co-authorship and equal compensation.
